Required Documentation and Information from Soy Grower

Documentation – The following evidence is available to assure compliance with SSAP-RED requirements: * maps of all fields, field sizes, legal title to farm, contractual agreements with subcontractors and elevators/first gathering points and delivery notes/weighbridge tickets for elevators/first gathering points.

Converted Land – Since January 1, 2008, no land has been converted from forest, grassland, peatland or wetland into production. This is applicable for all land owned and leased, and for all crops grown under above-mentioned trading entity.

Biodiversity – No land with high biodiversity value, high carbon stock or peatland has been converted to farmland since January 1, 2008.

Best Practices – The soy is produced in an environmentally responsible way, including protection of natural water courses, groundwater and irrigation, soil conservation, prevention of erosion and preservation of organic matter and soil structure. Good agricultural practices, especially for application of fertilizers and pesticides, including disposal of waste and empty plant protection product containers, are implemented.

Farm Safety – Plant protection products are applied and stored in a safe and environmentally responsible way in compliance with SSAP-RED requirements, e.g., chemicals are labelled and stored securely, well ventilated and on sealed floors. Safe working conditions are ensured through training, education, use of protective clothing and proper and timely assistance in the event of accidents.
